

# Northamptonshire County Golf Club Junior Open 2010

Welcome to the 2010 Junior Open, Organisers and Competitors attention is drawn to the following rules:

- Competitors must be under the age of 18 on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2010 and must have attained a handicap of 24 or less for the boys and 36 or less for the Girls at time of entry.
- Competitors are requested to observe a reasonable standard of dress and etiquette whilst on the course and in the clubhouse. Denim jeans, trainers, tracksuits and round neck tee shirts are not permitted either on or off the golf course and caps should be worn with the peaks forward.
- Gentlemen are permitted to wear **tailored shorts** on the course but not in the dining room after 6pm. **The wearing of tailored shorts must be accompanied with knee length socks.**
- The use of Caddies or trolley pullers is not permitted in this competition. Parents and supporters are welcome but we strongly advise that they walk at the sides of the fairways only and away from all competitors, they may assist in ball spotting but should not give advice.

Please help your child to prepare for this event by making sure that they have all the necessary equipment, food, drinks ( eg Sun Cream, Hats, Water, Food and suitable clothing), Water is available on the 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> holes.

In the event of a threat of thunder and lightning a continuous klaxon blast will sound, this will suspend play immediately, you will be required to mark your ball and then leave the course, a Klaxon will sound three times to recommence play, **failure to comply with suspension of play will lead to disqualification.**

The Club cannot accept any liability for injury caused to other persons by visiting players whilst on club property and all players acknowledge that they enter onto the course or into the club premises at their own risk and consent to the risk of loss, damage or injury however so caused.

**Competitors are requested to report to the check in 30 minutes before their start time.  
A current handicap certificate will be required on the day.**
